Every residential customer's garbage, recycling, and yard debris collection day will change during the weeks of Christmas and New Year's this year. If your service day falls on or after the Holiday your pick up will be delayed one day. Please remember to place your carts out to the curb by 6am on your Holiday schedule service day.

**Collection on or after the holiday is delayed one day!**

**FRIDAY customers will be serviced on SATURDAY**



**Extreme Weather Delays:** If for any reason your collection is prevented because of extreme weather conditions (snow, ice storm, flooding etc.), your collection will be picked up the following day. If for any reason your collection is missed altogether, please store material until your next regularly scheduled collection day. A double amount will be picked up at no extra charge. We apologize for any inconvenience caused by extreme weather delays, but the safety of the public, staff and drivers is very important to us.

**Tree Collection:** Allied Waste Services encourages you to contact your local Boy Scouts troop for collection services and dates. We will post local Troop information on our website [lakeoswego.disposal.com](http://lakeoswego.disposal.com) when it becomes available to us. Allied Waste Services can collect your Christmas tree in your yard debris cart on your regular service day. The trunk and branches must be cut into pieces less than 36 inches long and four inches in diameter. Bundles must be securely tied with string; weight limit is 60lbs. If you place your tree on the side of your cart for pick up you will be charged \$10. (up to a 8FT tree) Flocked trees are OK. No tinsel, decorations or stands.

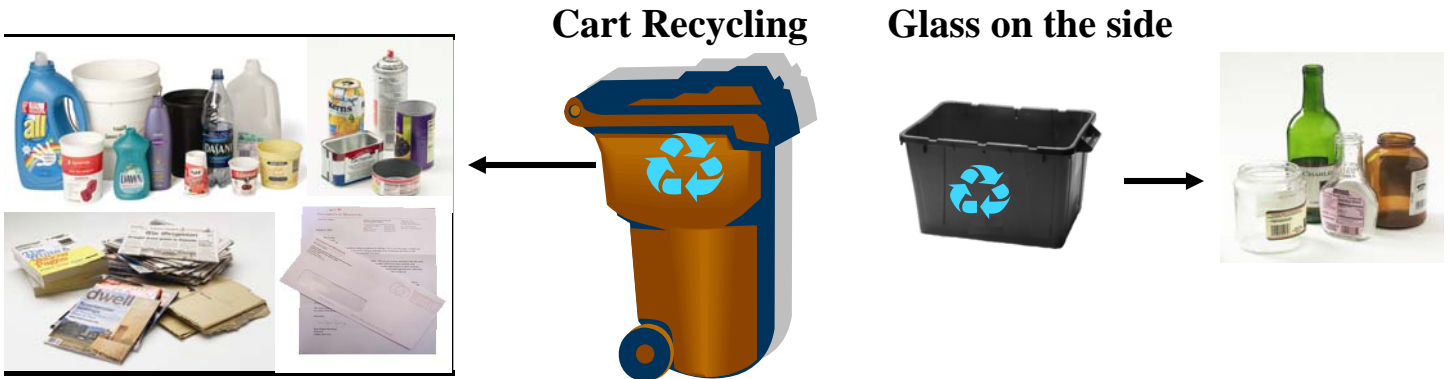


# Holiday Recycling & Garbage Reminders



With the arrival of the holiday and the New Year just around the corner, we understand that your garbage and recycling will increase significantly during the next two months. Below are a few reminders to keep your garbage and recycling piles under control.

**Along with your regular recyclables don't forget all those common holiday items such as wrapping paper, paper bags, paper rolls, & extra cardboard!**



**Please note the following common Holiday items are NOT recyclable in our program:**

**Styrofoam - plastic wrap – bows & ribbons – Christmas lights - plastic/wood toys**

## **E-Waste Recycling**



Allied Waste currently offers two ways to help you recycle your E-waste products. Households, small businesses and nonprofits with 10 or fewer employees, and anyone with seven or fewer items can recycle their computers, monitors and televisions by simply dropping off your covered electronic devices at Willamette Resources located at **10295 SW Ridder Rd in Wilsonville, Oregon**. You may also request a special pick up of your covered electronic device. Please contact the office during normal business hours for details or our special pick up program.



### Collection Reminders

- Please remember to have your carts and bins out to the curb at 6 am.
- Place at least two feet from other objects and carts.
- Please do not compact your yard debris and trash containers. Compacting your container increases your risk of a partial dump. If for any reason your container is partially dumped we ask that you loosen the material from the cart and call the office to arrange for extras to be picked up at no charge the following week.
- We gladly accept extra bags out to the curb on your service day. Please contact the office for rate information or to arrange a special pick up for larger quantities or items. We also offer temporary containers for your convenience.
