Rossman Sanitary Service, Inc. is pleased to provide garbage and recycling services to City of Lake Oswego customers.

These are your new carts for Garbage, Yard Debris and Recycling collection.



Please note the following helpful information:

1. Place carts and bin within 3 ft. of the curb, before 6 a.m. on your collection day.
2. Please arrange carts and bin with **at least 2 feet between them** so the trucks' hydraulic arms fit between each cart. To avoid damage, do not place carts within 2 feet of mailboxes, cars, telephone poles, trees, etc.
3. Please place loose items, such as kitty litter, other pet waste, and foam peanuts **in a sealed bag** to prevent spilling when the garbage cart is emptied. *(Foam peanuts can be taken to a mailing service for re-use.)*
4. We encourage you to set out your recycling and yard debris carts and bin **only when full**, or manageable. This makes collection more efficient and controls costs.
5. Please note the labels on each cart specifying the items to be placed inside.

In the TAN Cart



All Recyclables Except Glass and Motor Oil

Mixed Papers

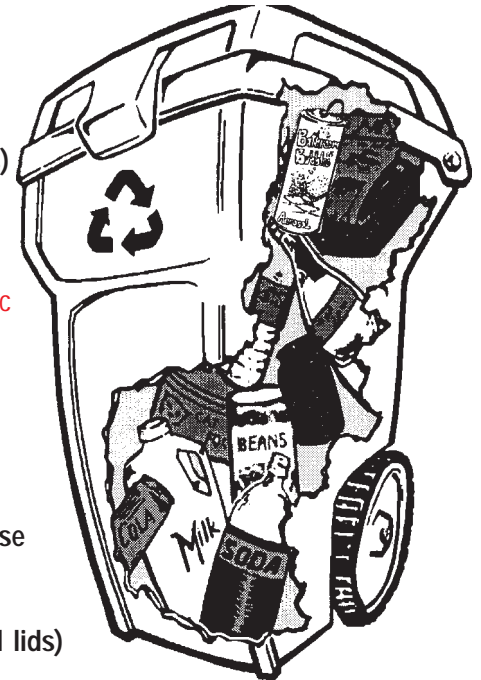
Newspapers
Opened junk mail (no need to bag)
Magazines, catalogs & phone books
Corrugated cardboard (flattened)
Cereal/shoe type boxes (discard liners)
Paper bags
Soda & beer cartons
Paper egg cartons

**NO toweling, tissues, foil, or waxy, plastic or food-contaminated papers*

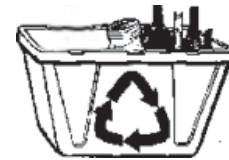
AND

These Items

Metal cans: steel & aluminum
(rinse and remove labels)
Plastic bottles: neck narrower than base
(rinse bottles & discard caps)
**NO plastic bags, tubs or Styrofoam®*
Aerosol cans: must be empty, (discard lids)
Milk cartons & drink boxes
(rinse, flatten, discard straws)
Scrap metal



In the ORANGE Bin



Glass Bottles & Jars: Place rinsed, loose, unbroken glass in bin (recycle metal lids with metals, discard plastic lids, no bags). **Please set out only when full or manageable.**

Motor Oil: Recycle in an unbreakable, see-through container no larger than 2 gallons with a screw top lid. **Place next to orange bin.**



Place carts and bin within 3 feet of the curb before 6 a.m.

On-call customers - call us at 503-636-3011 a day in advance of garbage pick up.

Once-a-month customers - your garbage will be collected the last week of each month. Yard debris and recycling may be set out weekly, or preferably when full.

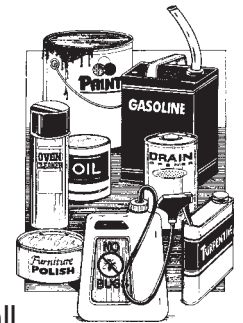
Holiday collection - If your collection day falls on Christmas and New Year's Day, you will be collected the following day, this pushes all collections one day late ending with Friday customers being collected on Saturday. **No other holidays effect your collection schedule.**

Collection service for large unwanted items - we can pick up appliances, tires, furniture and other large discards.

3 yard containers and large drop boxes are available for clean up projects. Call for details.

Household hazardous waste - please do not put hazardous or medical waste in your carts or bin. For safe disposal options or alternatives to hazardous products, call 503-557-6363.
